The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 11th, March 2016.

The Board decided to refuse permission generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the reasons and considerations as set out below.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the established pattern of development in the vicinity of South Avenue, in particular, the two primary schools Saint Brigids and Saint Patricks, in which some 650 pupils aged between 3 – 13 years are enrolled, it is considered that temporary use of South Avenue access road linking Bothar Brugha to our Lady of Lourdes Hospital Drogheda, would give rise to unacceptable construction traffic accessing via the shared space, between the two accesses to the two primary schools, would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard for users of the schools and would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
