CH3247/JP0038 Order of Proceedings at the Oral Hearing

- **Inspector's Introduction**

Subject to the discretion of the Inspector, the order of submissions shall be as follows:

- **Local Authority Submission**

The Local Authority shall present a description of both the appropriate assessment and the compulsory purchase order cases. The presentation should focus on new material only and in particular the response to the Further Information Request and the response to same from the objector.

- **Objector Submission**

The objector shall present a submission of the current position in relation to both the appropriate assessment and the compulsory purchase order cases. The presentation should focus primarily on their response to the Further Information and concerns arising from same.

- **Prescribed Bodies**

The presentation shall focus on the issues raised in the Oral Hearing dated the 28th day of June 2016 and the responses from the Local Authority and the Objector in relation to same.

Cross Questioning

1. Cross Questioning of the Local Authority by the Objector.
2. Cross Questioning of the Objector by the Local Authority.
3. Inspector's Questions.

Order of Closing Submissions

Closing submissions will be invited in the following order. The parties shall note that **no legal arguments, new material or issues may be produced at this point.**

1. Closing Statement by Objector.
2. Closing Statement by Local Authority.

NOTE: Submissions already made to the Board should be taken as read and should not be repeated. Furthermore, participants are requested to make available sufficient number of copies of any written documentation at the hearing (minimum of 2 copies to the Inspector).

Form of Proceedings at the Oral Hearing

Parties are reminded that the hearing is designed to allow further elaboration, discussion and examination of relevant issues over and above the written submissions in relation to the above named compulsory purchase order and appropriate assessment cases. The order of proceedings may be subject to change depending on attendance on the day of the hearing at the discretion of the Inspector. Parties should note that the previous submissions made in conjunction at the previous oral hearings on these cases need not be repeated and the hearing will focus on new matters arising since the closing of the hearings previously, including the Further Information Response received by An Bord Pleanála dated the 31st of July 2017.
