The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report and addendum report were further considered at a Board meeting held on 18th May 2011.

The Board generally agreed with the Inspector's conclusions, as set out in the Addendum to the Inspector's Report of 27th April 2011, in relation to the information (including revised Environmental Impact Statement) submitted by the applicant on 3rd August 2010 on foot of the notice issued under Section 37F(1)(b) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended. In particular, the Board concluded that:

- (a) The revised proposal for the incineration facility does not adequately comply with the specific requirement, set out in the notice issued under Section 37F(1)(b), to redesign the development so as to omit facilities to cater for municipal waste and to reduce the scale of the proposed development to reflect this requirement;
- (b) That the revised particulars in relation to works to prevent flooding of the road leading to the site are inadequate and
- (c) That additional information in respect of works to prevent significant erosion of the site (should such be required in the future) is inadequate.

Accordingly, the Board decided at the meeting of the 18th May 2011, on a vote of 5:1, to refuse permission, subject to the approval of the final draft reasons and considerations at a subsequent meeting.
