An Bord Pleanála proposes to draft a new Irish language scheme in accordance with sections 11 and 15 of the Official Languages Act 2003. The aim of the 2003 Act is to increase and improve the quantity and quality of services provided for the public through Irish by public bodies.

The new scheme, which will replace the Board's first scheme, will be implemented over a three year period from 2010-2013.
