Dear Mr.Cox,

I refer to the Projects of Common Interest permit granting and public participation process and the application lodged by EirGrid on 9th July, 2021 under Article 10 of Regulation (EU) number 347/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17th April 2013 on guidelines for trans-European energy infrastructure in relation to the Celtic Interconnector Project (Reference Number PCI 1.6).

You will be aware that Ireland to implement the permit granting process has chosen the collaborative scheme as the mechanism to facilitate the issuing of the comprehensive decision.

Comprehensive Decision

Having regard to Article 32 of Regulation (EU) 2022/869, the comprehensive decision means the decision of set of decisions taken by a Member State authority or authorities not including courts or tribunals, that determines whether or not a project promotor is to be granted authorisation to build the energy infrastructure to realise a project without prejudice to any decision taken in the context of an administrative appeal procedure.


