The Board decided to refuse permission generally in accordance with the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the long established usage of the sports ground to the west of the site the board considered that the western boundary treatment indicated on the original planning application, ref No 13/35825, was a more appropriate treatment and saw no reason to allow it to be changed.

In deciding not to accept the Inspector's recommendation to grant permission, the Board had regard to the longstanding use of the adjacent sports ground and considered that the boundary proposed would be injurious to the amenity of this facility.
