The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup>, July 2016.

The Board decided to refuse permission generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the reasons and considerations as set out below.

## **REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS**

- 1. The Ulster Canal is designated under the Monaghan County Development Plan 2013-2019 as an Area of Secondary Special Amenity Value and the part of the canal within the site is zoned under objective 'H' for recreation and amenity. The bridge whose retention is proposed would not be in keeping with the historic form, function and character of the Ulster Canal, would be visually obtrusive and would seriously detract from the amenity value of the canal. The development would, therefore, be contrary to the provisions of the development plan and to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
- 2. The retention of the bridge would militate against the reopening of the Ulster Canal and would, therefore, materially contravene objective ST04 of the development plan.
