REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the nature, scale and design of the proposed development and to the existing pattern of development in the vicinity of the site it is considered that the development as indicated in the documentation submitted to the planning authority could be satisfactorily accommodated on the site without serious injury to the visual amenities of the area or to the residential amenities of surrounding dwellings, Accordingly, the Board considered that condition number 3 as attached to the planning authority notification of decision to grant planning permission would be unwarranted.
