REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the reductions in development levies in respect of Telecommunications Masts as provided for under the terms of the Wexford County Council Development Contribution Scheme, 2013 apply in respect of the granting of temporary planning permissions and that the development proposed is not temporary in nature, this provision in the Development Contribution Scheme is not applicable in this instance. The Board noted that a financial contribution had not been levied under the terms of any previous grant of planning permission for this mast and considered that the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme had been properly applied in this instance and there were no discounts or reductions provided under the terms of the scheme that could be availed of by the developer.
