Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the fact that there are no exemptions or waivers within the Kildare County Council Development Contribution Scheme, 2015-2022 applicable to such developments for retention permission; no previous development contributions have been paid with respect of the dwelling on site; and no evidence has been submitted as regards to the floor area of the original dwelling on site, it is considered that the terms of the Kildare County Development Contribution Scheme 2015 – 2022 have been properly applied in this case.
