The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a further Board meeting held on 13th October, 2017.

The Board decided to refuse permission, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

## Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the existing deficiencies in the sewage treatment system serving Ballyliffin, which is currently overloaded, it is considered that the proposed development would generate additional waste water which would exacerbate the existing deficiencies, impacting on the environment and public health. The proposed development would, as such, be prejuduicial to public health and would pose an unacceptable risk of environmental pollution and would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
