## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the nature and scale of the development to be retained (namely a long standing domestic extension to the rear of the dwelling), it is considered that the imposition of Condition number 2 - requiring extensive works to the roadside entrance and boundary, removal of historical features and potentially loss of trees - would be disproportionate and excessive and is not justified in terms of the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
