The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 3rd August 2017.

The Board decided to refuse permission, by a 2:1 majority, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

- 1. Having regard to the location of the proposed development off an existing access road serving a housing estate, it is considered that the intensification of traffic use which would be involved in the change of use to a pre-school facility together with the hours of operation of such a facility, would lead to increased levels of noise to existing residents, would lead to unacceptable levels of traffic through a residential area and would seriously injure the residential amenity of nearby residents. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
- Furthermore, it is considered that the development is premature pending the realisation of the proposed upgrade to the existing laneway to the southwest of the application site.
