Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the nature of the condition the subject of the appeal, the Board is satisfied that the determination by the Board of the relevant application as if it had been made to it in the first instance would not be warranted. It is considered that the proliferation of entrances along this short length of road frontage is unwarranted on grounds of traffic safety and the imposition of condition no. 2 is justified in the interest of reducing traffic hazard.
