The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on October 5th 2017.

The Board decided to refuse permission, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

The development for which retention is sought is located in a village which does not have a public wastewater treatment plant. The development is currently served by a wastewater treatment system located off-site, which has not been demonstrated to be available to the applicant, and therefore does not have access to a suitable private wastewater treatment system over which it has sufficient rights to operate, maintain and take corrective action as necessary. The development cannot provide an on-site wastewater treatment system to comply with the EPA *Code of Practice: Wastewater Treatment and Disposal Systems Serving Single Houses (p.e.* \leq 10). The development for which retention is sought would therefore be prejudicial to public health and contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
