

Board Direction PL 05E.248403

Re: Amending Board Order S146A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended

The submissions on this file were considered at a Board meeting held on 15th March 2018.

The Board decided to exercise its powers under section 146A(1)(b) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, to amend its Order of 20th September 2017.

The Board decided that a clerical error had occurred. It is considered that amendment of the Board Order would not result in a material alteration of the terms of the development, the subject of the permission or decision.

Having regard to the nature of the issue involved, the Board decided not to invite submissions in relation to the matter from any person who had made submissions or observations to the Board in relation to the permission.

Accordingly the Board hereby amends the above-mentioned decision in accordance with the provisions of section 146A(1) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, as follows:

- 6. (a) During the operational phase of the proposed development, the noise level arising from the development, as measured at the nearest dwelling or at any point along the boundary of the site shall not exceed:
 - An Leq,1h value of 55 dB(A) during the period 08.00 to 18.00 hours from Monday to Friday inclusive and between 08.00 hours and 14.00 hours on Saturdays.
 - (ii) An Leq, 15 min value of 45 dB(A) at any other time. The noise at such time shall not contain a tonal component.

At no time shall the noise generated on site result in an increase in noise level of more than 10dB(A) above background levels at the boundary of the site.

 (b) All sound measurement shall be carried out in accordance with ISO Recommendation 1996:2007: Acoustics - Description and Measurement of Environmental Noise.

Reason: To protect the residential amenities of property in the vicinity of the site.
