The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 26/04/2018.

The Board decided to refuse permission, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the planning history of the appeal site, the existing character and the prevailing pattern of development in the area, the visually-prominent site location within an Architectural Conservation Area and the objectives and provisions of the Fingal Development Plan 2017-2023, it is considered that the development for which retention is sought, by reason of its siting forward of the established building line, would form an obtrusive, dominant and discordant feature in the streetscape and would not respect or complement the character of the shopfront on site.

Furthermore, the development for which retention is sought fails to enhance the character of the Architectural Conservation Area and Malahide village centre, would seriously injure the visual amenities of the area and would set an undesirable precedent for similar development. The development for which retention is sought would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
