

## **Board Direction BD-000393-18 ABP-300531-17**

The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 31.05.2018.

The Board determined, generally in accordance with the inspector's recommendation, that, based on the information before it, the site is not a vacant site within the meaning of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act, 2015, for the following reasons and considerations.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to:

- (a) The information submitted to the Board by the Planning Authority in relation to the entry of the site on the Vacant Sites Register.
- (b) The grounds of appeal submitted by the appellant.
- (c) The report of the Inspector.
- (d) The lack of boundary walls or fences separating the site from the wider HSE landholding; the site forms an integral part of the overall facility and provides users and staff with open space and recreational opportunities.

The Board considers that it is appropriate that a notice be issued to the Planning Authority to cancel the entry on the Vacant Sites Register.
