The Board decided to grant permission generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations, and subject to the following conditions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the provisions of the Dun Laoghaire- Rathdown County
Development Plan 2016-2022 and the Goatstown Local Area Plan 2012, to the
planning history of the site, the pattern of development in the area and the density,
scale and design of the proposed development, it is considered that, subject to
compliance with the conditions set out below, the proposed development would not
seriously injure the amenities of the area or of property in the vicinity, was
acceptable in terms of open space provision, would not give rise to a car dominated
layout and would be acceptable in terms of traffic safety and convenience and
retention of trees on the site. The proposed development would, therefore, be in
accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
