At a meeting held on 16th May 2018, the Board considered the report of the Assistant Director of Planning, as well as the documents and submissions on file.

The Board determined that the proposed developments consisting of three new STATCOM devices at three existing substation sites at the 220/110kV substation at Ballyvouskill, Co. Cork, the 220/110kV substation at Ballynahulla, Co. Kerry and the 110kV substation at Thurles, Co. Tipperary as set out in the plans and particulars received by An Bord Pleanala on the 14th March 2018 do not fall within the scope of section 182A of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and that separate planning applications should be made in the first instance to Cork, Kerry and Tipperary County Councils respectively.
