Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the nature and scale of the proposed development for retention, including the set back of the rear dormer window extension from eaves level, and the pattern of development in the area, including a variety of rear dormer window extensions in the vicinity of the subject site, it is considered that the modifications to the proposed development, as required by the Planning Authority in its imposition of condition number 2, are not warranted, and that the proposed development, as described on the documentation submitted with the application and the omission of condition number 2, would not have a significant impact on the amenities of the area or on the residential amenities of property in the vicinity, would be acceptable within the streetscape and would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area
