Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the provisions of the current Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Development Plan 2016-2022, to the pattern of development in the area, to previous precedents of similar development and to the nature, form, scale and design of the proposed development, it is considered that, subject to compliance with the conditions set out below, the proposed development, including the first floor extension that projects beyond the rear elevation of the dwelling accommodating a WC/bathroom, would not seriously injure the residential or visual amenities of the area. The proposed development would be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
