At a meeting held on 20/11/19, the Board considered the report of the Planning Inspector, as well as the documents and submissions on file, in relation to the proposed windfarm of up to 28 wind turbines with a combined power energy output greater than 50MW, on lands at Clongawny and Drinagh, Derrinlough, County Offaly.

The Board determined, in accordance with the Inspector's reasoning and recommendation, that the proposed development constitutes strategic infrastructure development, as defined by Section 2(1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended by Section 6 of the Planning and Development (Strategic Infrastructure) Act 2006, and that a planning application should be made directly to the Board.
