

Board Direction BD-004394-19 ABP-303322-18

At a meeting held on 01/11/2019, the Board considered the report of the Planning Inspector, as well as the documents and submissions on file, in relation to the proposed windfarm of up to 27 wind turbines (with a combined approximate yield of 105MW), together with 2 electricity substations and battery storage, on lands at Bottlehill, Mullenaboree, Knockdoorty and Glannasack, County Cork.

The Board determined, in accordance with the Inspector's reasoning and recommendation, that the proposed development constitutes strategic infrastructure development as defined by section 2(1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended by section 6 of the Planning and Development (Strategic Infrastructure) Act 2006, and that a planning application should be made directly to the Board.
