- (e) The erection of new hoarding,
- (f) The lack of visibility of the interior of the site from the public realm,

it was considered that the site no longer has adverse effects on existing amenities or reduces the amenity provided by existing infrastructure and facilities in the area and no longer has adverse effects on the character of the area.
