

Board Direction BD-004707-19 ABP-304080-19

At a meeting held on 09/12/2019, the Board considered:

- (a) the objections made to the Compulsory Purchase Order,
- (b) the report of the Senior Inspector who held the oral hearing and
- (c) the documents and submissions on file generally.

The Board decided to confirm the Order with modifications for the following Reasons and Considerations and as set out in the schedule hereunder.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having considered the objections made to the compulsory purchase order and the report of the person who conducted the oral hearing into the objections, and having regard to the provisions of the Water Framework Directive (2000/60/EC), the Urban Wastewater Treatment Directive (91/271/EEC), the current Cork County Council Development Plan 2014-2020, and the Blarney Macroom Municipal District Local Area Plan 2017, it is considered that the acquisition of lands, wayleaves, rights of way and temporary working areas by Irish Water is necessary for the purposes stated in the Order and the objections cannot be sustained having regard to the said necessity.

The compulsory purchase order shall be modified in accordance with details
provided in the documentation submitted to An Bord Pleanála at the oral hearing on
the 19 th day of November 2019 as follows and specifically the realignment of Plot
Numbers 10, 11 and 12 as indicated on Drawing IW/10015227/CWL/002 Rev 6.
