

## **Board Direction BD-004556-19 ABP-304436-19**

At a meeting held on 20/11/2019, the Board considered the report of the Planning Inspector, as well as the documents and submissions on file, in relation to the proposed back-filling of a quarry void with soil and stone waste, together with associated infrastructure and site works, at Bay Lane Quarry, St. Margaret's in North County Dublin.

Having regard to the size, scale, location and limited duration of the proposed development and the proximity of source material, the Board determined that the proposed development constitutes development that falls within the definition of infrastructure in the Seventh Schedule of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, but is considered not to be of strategic importance by reference to the requirements of Section 37A(2)(a), (b) and (c) of the Act. An application for permission for the proposed development directly to An Bord Pleanála under Section 37E of the Act is therefore not required.
