

## Board Direction BD-004736-19 ABP-304968-19

The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 12/12/2019.

The Board decided to refuse permission, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

## Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the location of the proposed multi-use entertainment facility in close proximity to residential dwellings, to the frequency and hours of operation of the use, and to the lack of adequate baseline information or predicted noise levels in respect of these sensitive receptors in the application and appeal documents, it is considered that the proposed development and the development proposed for retention, notwithstanding the mitigation measures proposed in the noise assessment reports, would seriously injure the amenities of properties in the vicinity by reason of noise and general disturbance and would depreciate the value of properties in the area. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
