## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the existing furniture, features and utilities on the street, the high volume of pedestrian movements, it is considered that the placing of furniture on the footpath would significantly interfere with pedestrian movement on this busy innercity thoroughfare, would be prejudicial to pedestrian safety and would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
