## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the provisions of the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County
Development Plan 2016-2022, the established pattern of development and to the
nature and scale of the proposed first floor rear extension, it is considered that the
first floor extension would not be overly dominant and overbearing when viewed from
the adjoining property to the north development and would not seriously injure the
amenities of the area or of property in the vicinity. The proposed development would
therefore be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

In deciding not to accept the inspectors recommendation to attach condition 2 the Board was satisfied that the proposed development would not injure the visual amenities of the area or the streetscape and was in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.
