

Board Direction BD-005763-20 ABP-306050-19

The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 15/05/2020.

The Board decided to refuse permission, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

- 1. Having regard to the soil conditions on site, the Board is not satisfied, on the basis of the submissions made in connection with the planning application and the appeal, that effluent from the development can be satisfactorily treated and disposed of on site, notwithstanding the proposed use of a proprietary wastewater treatment system. The proposed development would, therefore, be prejudicial to public health and would be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
- 2. On the basis of the information provided with the application and appeal, including the Natura Impact Statement, and in light of the assessment carried out, the Board is not satisfied that the proposed development individually, or in combination with other plans or projects, would not adversely affect the integrity of European sites Nos. 004110 and 00165 (Lough Nillan Bog SPA and Lough Nillan Bog (Carrickatlieve) SAC) in view of the site's Conservation Objectives. In such circumstances the Board is precluded from granting permission.

3.	Having regard to the location of the access/egress point onto a regional road
	served by a continuous white line and where the speed limit of 80km/hr
	applies, it is considered that the introduction of an additional dwelling would
	result in the material intensification of traffic movements at this access/egress
	point onto the public road network, which would endanger public safety by
	reason of traffic hazard. The proposed development would, therefore, be
	contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
