At a meeting held on 04/08/2021, the Board considered the report of the Planning Inspector, as well as the documents and submissions on file, in relation to the proposed development, comprising the development of a 9-turbine windfarm, together with associated grid connection infrastructure and site works at Bracklyn, County Westmeath.

Having regard to the size, scale and location of the proposed windfarm and related development, the Board determined that the proposed development constitutes development that falls within the definition of strategic infrastructure in the Seventh Schedule and is considered to be of strategic importance by reference to the requirements of Section 37A(2)(a), (b) & (c) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. An application for permission for the proposed development must, therefore, be made directly to An Bord Pleanála under Section 37E of the Act.
