At a meeting held on 11/06/2021, the Board considered:

- (a) the objections made to the Compulsory Purchase Order,
- (b) the report of the Inspector who held the oral hearing and
- (c) the documents and submissions on file generally.

The Board decided by a majority of 2:1 to confirm the Order without modification.

Reasons and Considerations

Having considered the objections made to the compulsory purchase order and the report of the person who conducted the oral hearing into the objections, to the Book of Evidence which sets out the use of the plots to be acquired in the Burtonport Harbour Development Scheme, and having regard to the core policy objectives of the Donegal County Development Plan 2018-2024 which identify Burtonport as having a special economic function in the thematic areas of the marine, tourism and the Wild Atlantic Way as well as being identified for a town enhancement scheme to strengthen this community, it is considered that the acquisition of lands by Donegal County Council is necessary for the purposes stated in the order, and the objections cannot be sustained having regard to the said necessity.
