

Board Direction BD-006071-20 ABP-306700-20

At a meeting held on 09/07/2020, the Board considered the objection made to the Compulsory Purchase Order, the report of the Inspector and the documents and submissions on file generally.

The Board decided to grant consent to the Order without modification, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the neglected, unsightly and objectionable condition of the site, which is in a ruinous and dangerous state, with the open storage of waste materials, it is considered that the site detracts to a material degree from the amenity, character and appearance of land in the neighbourhood and, therefore, comes within the definition of a derelict site as defined in section 3 of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, as amended, and that the acquisition of the site by the local authority is necessary in order to render the site non-derelict and to prevent it continuing to be a derelict site. It is also considered that the objection made cannot be sustained having regard to that said necessity.
