

Board Direction BD-010440-22 ABP-309375-21

At a meeting held on 04/04/2022, the Board considered the report of the Inspector, and the documents and submissions on file generally, in respect of the proposed development of Phase 3 of the Oweninny windfarm comprising 18 wind turbines with an approximate generating capacity of 90MW in the townlands of Laghtanvack, Croaghaun (also known as Croaghaun West), Moneynieran, Corvoderry, Shanvolahan, Dooleeg More and Shanvodinnaun, County Mayo

The Board decided that the proposed development would exceed the threshold set out in the Seventh Schedule of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, thereby satisfying the requirements of Section 37A(1) of the Act. It can also be determined that the development is of strategic importance by reference to the requirements of Section 37A(2)(a) and Section 37A(2)(b) of the Act. An application for permission for the proposed development must, therefore, be made directly to An Bord Pleanála under Section 37E of the Act.
