to the zoning provisions for the area, would not seriously injure the residential or
commercial amenities or depreciate the value of properties in the area, and would,
therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of
the area.

1. The delivery hours of the take away and restaurant use shall be extended to 12.30 am Monday to Sunday including bank holidays.
