The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 15/02/2022.

The Board decided to refuse permission, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

It is considered that, having regard to the fundamental road safety concerns raised as a result of the proposed provision of a raised table on the Carley's Bridge Road, in place of a dedicated pedestrian footpath, and having regard to the limited forward visibility at the location of the proposed raised table, as a result of the variable horizontal and vertical alignment of the Carley's Bridge Road, and having regard to the proposed provision of a vehicle access/egress point close to the location of the existing rural speed limit zone (80km/h), and the uncertainty in relation to the altering of same, the proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
