

Board Direction BD-014890-23 ABP-312050-21

At a meeting held on 18/12/2023, the Board considered the objection made to the compulsory acquisition of the site in question, the report of the Inspector and the documents and submissions on file generally.

Accordingly, the Board decided to confirm the compulsory acquisition of the site, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the derelict state of the site and its neglected, unsightly and objectionable condition, the Board considers that the site detracts to a material degree from the amenity, character and appearance of land in the neighbourhood and, therefore, comes within the definition of a derelict site as defined in Sections 3(b) of the Derelict Sites Act 1990, as amended, and that the compulsory acquisition of the site by the local authority is necessary to render the site non-derelict and to prevent it from continuing to be a derelict site. It is also considered that the objection made against such acquisition cannot be sustained, having regard to that said necessity.
