

Board Direction BD-012005-23 ABP-312434-22

The submissions on file and the inspector's report were considered at a Board Meeting held on 04/04/2023.

Having regard to the size, scale and location of the proposed windfarm and related development, the Board decided that the proposed development comprising the development of a 13-turbine windfarm with associated infrastructure (including a 110kV grid connection) and site works at Ballynaguilkee Upper, Broemountain, Corradoon, Dyrick, Lickoran, Lickoranmountain, Lisleagh, Lisleaghmountain, Lyrattin and Scartmountain. Co Waterford constitutes development that falls within the definition of energy infrastructure in the Seventh Schedule of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, thereby satisfying the requirements set out in section 37A(1) of the Act.

The proposed development is also considered to be of strategic importance by reference to the requirements of section 37A(2)(a) and section 37A 2(b) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. An application for permission for the proposed development must therefore be made directly to An Bord Pleanala under section 37E of the Act.
