

Board Direction BD-012094-23 ABP-312446-22

At a meeting held on 8th May 2023, the Board considered the report of the Inspector, and the documents and submissions on file generally in respect of the proposed further development of Drehid Waste Management Facility.

The Board decided that the proposed development as set out in the plans and particulars received by An Bord Pleanála on 12 January 2021 falls within the class of development as set out in the Seventh Schedule of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended. The proposed development is also considered to be of strategic importance by reference to one or more of the requirements of section 37A(2) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. Therefore, it is concluded that the proposed development constitutes strategic infrastructure development.

Any application for permission for the proposed development must, therefore, be made directly to An Bord Pleanála under section 37E of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.
