

Board Direction BD-013917-23 ABP-313200-22

At a meeting held on 26/09/2023, the Board considered:

- (a) the objections made to the Compulsory Purchase Order,
- (b) the report of the Inspector and
- (c) the documents and submissions on file generally.

The Board decided to grant consent to the compulsory acquisition of the said site based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

It is considered that the site detracts to a material degree from the amenity, character, and appearance of the land in the neighbourhood, owing to the neglected, unsightly, and objectionable condition and, therefore, falls within the definition of a derelict site as defined in Section 3 (b) of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, (as amended), and that the acquisition of the site by the local authority is necessary in order to render the site non-derelict and to prevent it continuing to be a derelict site. It is also considered that the objections made cannot be sustained, having regard to that said necessity.
