

Board Direction BD-011107-22 ABP-313351-22

At a meeting held on 12/08/2022, the Board considered the report of the Inspector, and the documents and submissions on file generally, in relation to the proposed development, comprising 9 no. wind turbines with an overall tip height of 185m, together with a new 110kV substation with a grid connection at the existing 110kV substation outside Tullamore, County Offaly.

Having regard to the size, scale and location of the proposed wind farm and related development, and to the policy context, the Board decided that the proposed development constitutes development that falls within the definition of energy infrastructure in the Seventh Schedule of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, thereby satisfying the requirements set out in section 37A(1) of the Act. The proposed development is also considered to be of strategic importance by reference to the requirements of sections 37A(2)(a), (b) and (c) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. An application for permission for the proposed development must therefore be made directly to An Bord Pleanála under section 37E of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.
