The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 27/06/2023.

The Board decided to grant permission generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations, and subject to the following conditions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the pattern of development in the area and its residential zoning under the Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Development Plan 2022-2028, and to the standards for the development of corner/side gardens set out in section 12.3.7.5 of that Plan, it is considered that, subject to compliance with conditions below, the proposed house would not seriously injure the character of the area or the amenities of property in the vicinity and would be acceptable in terms of traffic safety and convenience. The proposed development would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area

Conditions

 The development shall be carried out in accordance with the plans and particulars lodged with the application, as amended by Further Information received by the planning authority on 02/03/2022 and Clarification of Further Information received by the planning authority on the 19/04/2022, except as may otherwise be required in order to comply with the following conditions. Where such conditions require details to be agreed with the planning authority, the developer shall agree such details in writing with the planning authority prior to commencement of development and the development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with the agreed particulars.

Reason: In the interest of clarity

2. Details of the materials, colours and textures of all the external finishes to the proposed dwellings and external boundary walls shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity.

3. Prior to the commencement of development, the developer shall submit to, and agree in writing with, the planning authority a Construction Method Statement for any works to the granite rubble stone wall that backs onto 'The Metals' in order to ensure the structural integrity of the existing boundary walls around the site

Reason: In order to protect architectural character and in the interest of visual amenity

4. Site development and building works shall be carried out only between the hours of 0800 to 1900 Mondays to Fridays inclusive, between 0900 to 1400 hours on Saturdays and not at all on Sundays and public holidays. Deviation from these times will only be allowed in exceptional circumstances where prior written approval has been received from the planning authority.

Reason: In order to safeguard the amenities of property in the vicinity.

5. All service cables associated with the proposed development (such as electrical, telecommunications and communal television) shall be located underground.

Reason: In the interests of visual and residential amenity.

6. Water supply and drainage arrangements including the attenuation and disposal of surface water, shall comply with the requirements of the planning authority for such works and services.
