

Board Direction BD-011422-22 ABP-314052-22

At a meeting held on 01/11/2022, the Board considered the report of the Inspector, and the documents and submissions on file generally, in respect of the proposed development, which comprises an increase in the annual intake of waste at the site located at the Millennium Business Park, Cappagh Road, Dublin 11, by 180,000 tonnes to a total annual waste intake of 450,000 tonnes.

The Board decided that the proposed development falls within the definition of Class 3 (Environmental Infrastructure) of the Seventh Schedule of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and exceeds the threshold for such waste installations and therefore satisfies section 37A(1) of the Act. It is also considered that the proposed development falls within the terms of section 37A(2)(a), (b) and (c) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, on the basis that the proposed development would be of strategic importance to the State and the Eastern and Midlands Region, within which it would be situate, would contribute substantially to the fulfilment of the objectives of the National Planning Framework and the Regional Spatial & Economic Strategy 2019-2031 for the Eastern and Midland Region in force in respect of the area in which it would be situate, and would have a significant effect on the area of more than one planning authority.
