The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on 30/01/2024.

The Board decided to refuse permission, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the Kerry County Development Plan 2022-2028, the location of the site in an area zoned "Other Rural Areas", Policy Objective KCDP 5-16 in relation to Other Rural Areas that seeks to accommodate demand for permanent residential development, Policy Objective KCDP 5-20 that seeks to ensure that all permitted residential development in rural areas is for use as a primary permanent place of residence, it is considered that the proposed development, which will not be the applicant's primary permanent place of residence, would materially contravene Policy Objectives KCDP 5-16 and KCDP 5-20 of the Kerry County Development Plan 2022-2028. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
