Re: Amending Board Order

Whereas the Board made a decision to grant a licence, subject to conditions, in relation to the above-mentioned development by Order dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023:

And whereas it has come to the attention of the Board that due to a clerical error, condition number 2 should be rectified to facilitate the operation of the permission:

And whereas the Board considered that the correction of the above-mentioned error would not result in a material alteration of the terms of the proposed development:

And whereas having regard to the nature of the issue involved, the Board decided not to invite submissions in relation to the matter from persons who had made submissions or observations in relation to the appeal the subject of this amendment:

Now therefore in accordance with section 146A(1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as inserted by section 30 of the Planning and Development (Strategic

Infrastructure) Act 2006, the Board hereby amends the above-mentioned decision so that condition number 2 of its Order shall be as follows:

The maximum height of the telecommunications street pole shall not exceed 18
metres and the maximum width of the structure shall not exceed 360 mm as
measured in drawing number SR-1280-103A as received by the planning
authority on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2021.
