Having regard to the decision of the planning authority to grant permission for retention of the development on 24th January 2023 and to the adopted Kildare County Development Contributions Scheme 2023-2029 (superseding the Kildare County Development Contributions Scheme 2015-2019) which came into effect on the 1st of January 2023 specifically noting Section 9 which sets out that no exemptions or waivers shall apply to any developments subject to retention permission, the Board was satisfied that, in attaching Condition No.6, the planning authority correctly applied the terms of the Kildare County Development Contributions Scheme 2023-2029.
