The submissions on file and the inspector's report were considered at a Board Meeting held on 09/10/2024.

The Board decided that Renewable Energy Systems be informed that the proposed development consisting of a 110kV substation, underground cables and related ancillary infrastructure within the townland of Ballyteige Little, County Offaly as set out in the plans, particulars and correspondence received by An Bord Pleanála on the on the 26<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and the 17<sup>th</sup> July 2013, falls within the scope of section 182A of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and that a planning application should be made directly to the Board.
