The submissions on file and the inspector's report were considered at a Board Meeting held on 30/01/2024.

The Board decided that the proposed development falls consisting of a 110kV substation and loop-in connection associated with an approved solar farm development, located at Stokesquarter, Painestown, Killary, Ricetown, Castletown K.P. Naven, County Meath, as described in the documents received by the Board on the 7th September 2023, falls within the scope of section 182A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, and that a planning application should be made directly to the Board.
