The submissions on file and the inspector's report were considered at a Board Meeting held on 15/05/2024.

The Board decided that the proposed development falls consisting of two no. substations and 220kV grid connection in the townlands of Ralappane, Kilcolgan Lower, Carhoonakineely, Carhoonakilla, Cockhill, Coolnanoonagh, Carhoona, Farranawana and Kilpaddoge, Tarbet, Co. Kerry, as described in the documents received by the Board on the 28th September 2023, 13th December 2023 and 29th April 2024 fall within the scope of section 182A of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, and that a planning application should be made directly to the Board.
